- **Kerr Together Long-Term Recovery Group – \$20,000:** Provided through the Kerrville Area Chamber of Commerce Foundation, this funding will support locally coordinated response and long-term recovery efforts to help address remaining needs of individuals, families and the community work toward recovery.

- **Rebuild Texas Fund – \$20,000:** This investment will support broader recovery and rebuilding needs associated with the Hill Country flooding through the OneStar Foundation.
