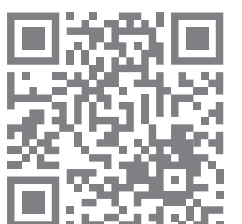

The following persons are not eligible for the reward: employees of Texas Mutual or members of their immediate families; the alleged perpetrator of the crime; and owners, officers, and managers of the Texas Mutual policyholder that employs the alleged perpetrator. The amount of the reward will be determined by the Texas Mutual Fraud Stoppers Committee and will depend on the significance of the information given for the investigation and the fraud amount identified.
