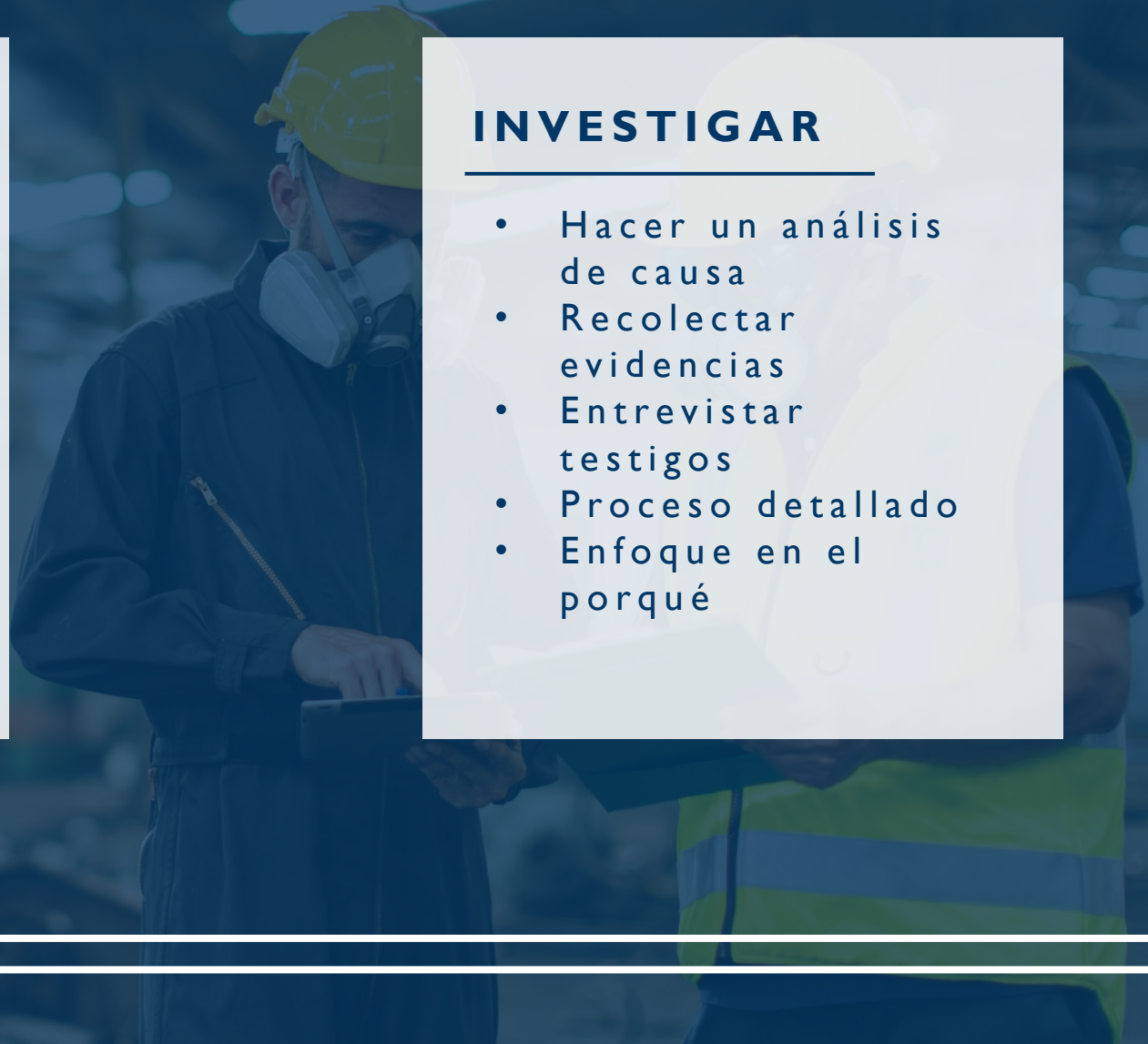
REPORTE VS. INVESTIGACIÓN

- Notificar el incidente
- Documentar datos básicos
- Cumplir requisitos legales

INVESTIGAR

- Hacer un análisis de causa
- Recolectar evidencias
- Entrevistar testigos
- Proceso detallado
- Enfoque en el porqué

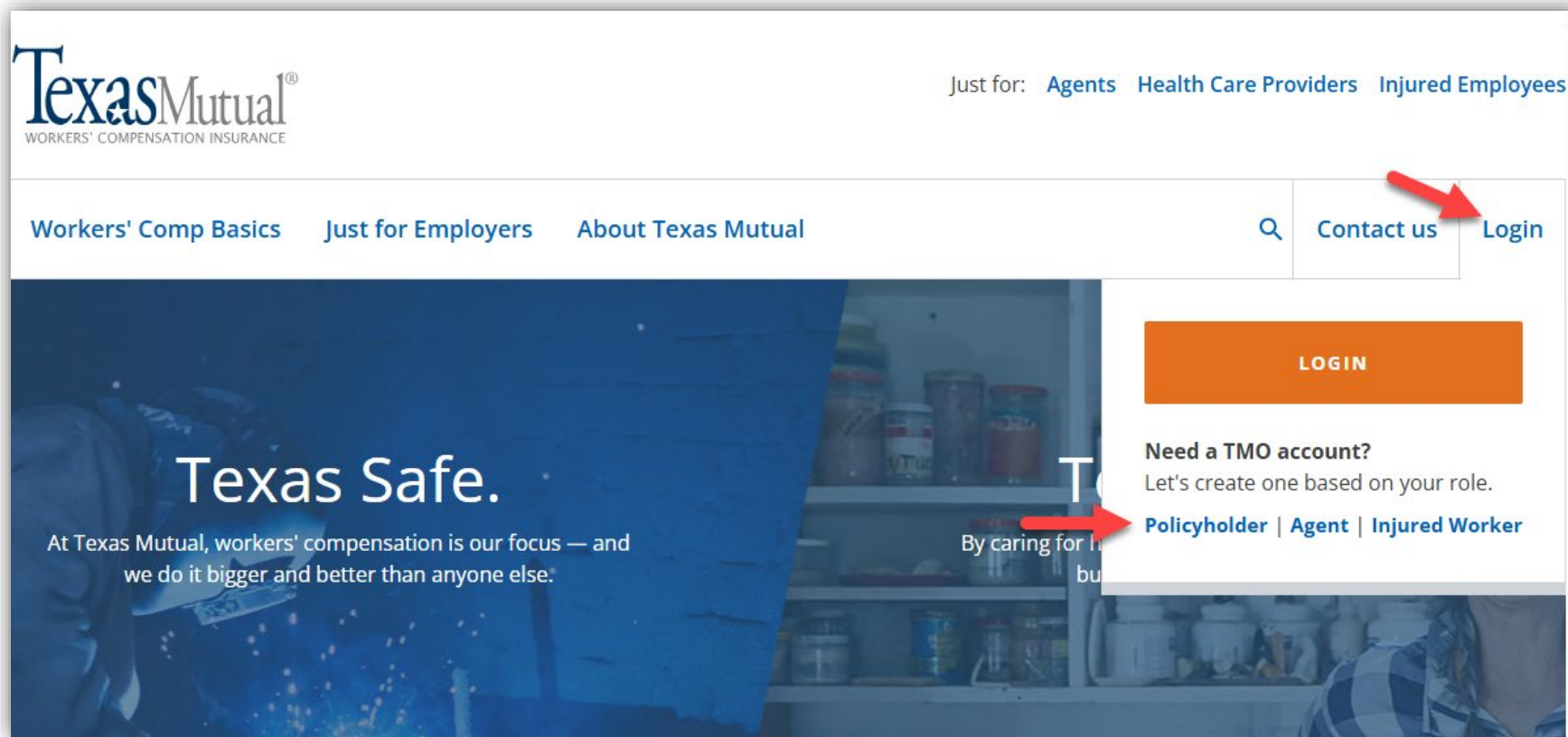

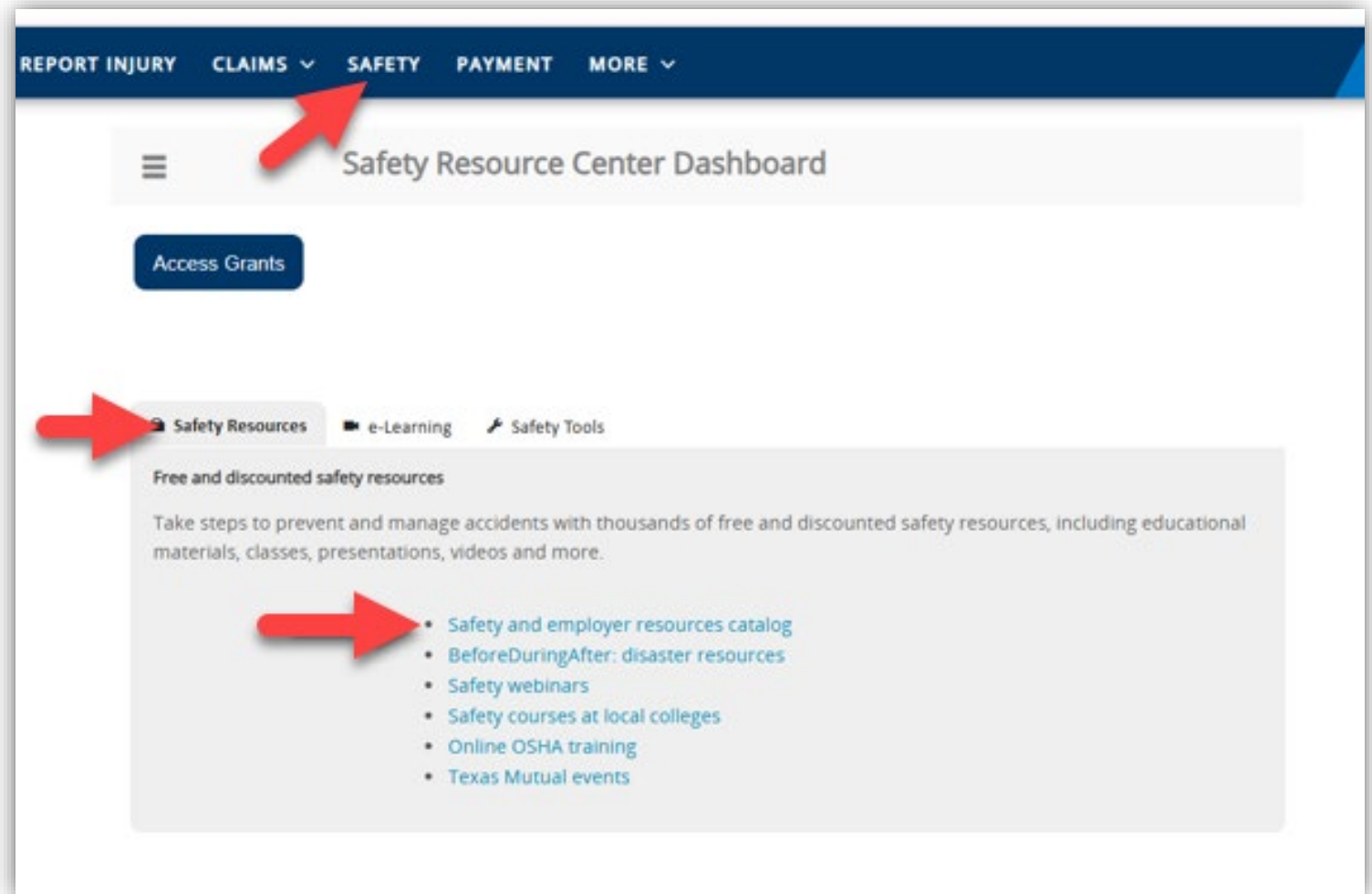

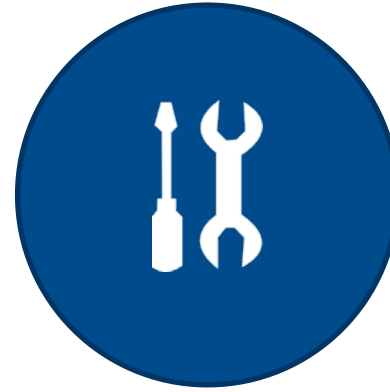
